Pennsylvania Virtual Chapter Guidelines

Who Can Join?

- Any student enrolled at a school in a business or business-related class that does NOT have an active FBLA chapter OR any home-schooled student.
- Students in schools with an active FBLA chapters are **NOT** permitted to be members of the virtual chapter.

How to Join

- Complete an on-line membership application at www.pafbla.org
- Ask parent or guardian to sign the application
- Pay dues of \$12 payable to "PA FBLA." (\$6 for state dues, \$6 for national dues)



Meetings

- Members must have a computer, an Internet connection, and a functioning e-mail address to attend virtual meetings.
- Meetings will be conducted monthly via a "virtual classroom."
- Chapter shall elect a president, vice-president, secretary, treasurer, historian, parliamentarian, and webmaster. Meetings of officers will occur virtually prior to the regular membership meeting.
- Committees may be established for the chapter as necessary, and all virtual members will be eligible to serve on committees.
- Chapter advisors shall be the members of the state management team, staff assistants, or others appointed by the Executive Director.



Finances

- All expenses for traveling for members or parents are the responsibility of the members, not PA FBLA.

Membership Benefits

- Participate in any special programs established by PA FBLA, such as Big 33, Keystone Leadership Award, etc.
- Attend the State Leadership Workshop with adult supervision, and the student and adult must comply with the Delegate Code of Conduct.
- Participate in any Pennsylvania FBLA function based on attendance restrictions that apply to those events.
- Attend the Region Leadership Workshop in your area where your home is located with adult supervision, and comply with the policies established by that region.
- Compete in the competitive events program in a "virtual region" with other virtual chapter members and cyber chapter school members. See competitive events brochure for more details.
- Participate at the State Leadership Conference or the National Leadership Conference and comply with the Delegate Code of Conduct and any other rules and regulations.
- Possibly serve as one of the two voting delegates at the SLC.
