Attach and label it "Item 55-1, Item 55-2, Item 55-3, etc."

- a. 1 service activity = 5 points
- b. 2 service activities = 10 points
- c. 3 service activities = 15 points
- d. 4 service activities = 20 points

Baskets for charity auctions of at least \$30 value count as one service activity. Baskets may be claimed for RLW, RLC, and the SLW.
