■ How do you apply for this award?

FBLA members must complete 15 of the 23 items listed on the entry form. All applicants MUST complete Item #1 under Service, #1 under Education, and #1 under Progress in order to be considered for this award.

- 3. Participate in a national or state FBLA program such as American Enterprise Day, Job Shadow Day, and Community Service Day, etc.

(Attach a typed description of your involvement in 100 words.)
