A supply chain consists of raw material extractors, component suppliers, assemblers, logistics providers, retailers, and financial institutions that facilitate the flows of materials, services, information, and money from the extraction of raw materials through the delivery of products or services to consumers. Supply Chain Management (SCM) focuses on optimizing these flows. It is the dominant business paradigm. SCM employment is forecast to grow 17-28% over the next decade. Key roles are procurement analysts, forecasters, SC planners, managers, and executives, and logisticians. The median wage for these jobs in Pennsylvania ranges from \$59,400 to \$87,300 based on 2013 data. At Bloomsburg University students learn about SCM in a new academic program (SCM Major) or an



existing specialization in the Management major and a very active APICS Student Chapter. This workshop introduces high school students to SCM and career opportunities. For educators, it describes Bloomsburg University's SCM programs and plans for periodic oncampus workshops about the principal tools and methods useful in SCM career paths.
