<u>Exhibitor Fees</u>, as adopted June, 2013, by the Pennsylvania FBLA Board of Directors, are listed below. The fees include one table with cover and chairs. If a power source is needed, there is an additional fee of \$45 per table.

- \$200 per table for educational institutions on FBLA's list of participating scholarship schools.
- \$300 per table for all other education institutions, fundraising companies, publishing companies, equipment-related companies, or merchandise vendors selling products
- \$45 per power source (additional)

Promotional Opportunities Available and Associated Fees

There are three different categories of sponsorship available for organizations or individuals to assist with the conference ranging in price from \$50-\$15,000. They are:

Competitive Events Sponsor (\$50-\$250 to co-sponsor and \$300 to sponsor a single event.)

Conference Sponsor, (\$150-\$450 to co-sponsor and \$500 to sponsor a single item)

<u>Title Sponsor</u> (\$5,000-\$15,000 to sponsor a single event)

Sponsorships are needed to fund the various activities of the SLC. The value of a sponsorship determines the level of publicity for your organization and how the funds will be allocated. For example, sponsoring one competitive event begins at \$50; sponsoring all 1,200+ competitive event awards would cost \$15,000. As a title sponsor, your organizations' name would be engraved on each award.
