Teams raising the most money will receive recognition & may also receive a bye in the tournament.

WANNA DLAY?

✓ Gather together a team of 6 to 8 members – Teams may be made up of members from different schools but members CANNOT be on more than one team

✓ Collect sponsors from various sources:

• Other FBLA members

• Community Businesses

• Teachers & Administrators

• Friends and Family

Make your minimum \$50 donation

- ✓ Complete and turn in the Team Entry Form along with your monetary donation
 - Team names and themes need to be school appropriate
 - The first 32 Teams to turn in an Entry Form and \$\$\$ will be Registered In order to allow as many schools as possible to participate, there will be a limit of one team per school.

If, upon arrival at the SLW, we have not received 32 teams, then we may accept addition teams from already registered teams.

An announcement will be made at the SLW Opening Session if this will take place

- ✓ Have each team member complete the Dodgeball Liability Waiver portion of the SLW Student Emergency Form
 - If not completed, the member MAY NOT participate

MORE DETAILS

- ✓ The tournament will be set up in a DOUBLE ELIMINATION bracket!
- ✓ Two teams will compete at a time
- ✓ All games will be 5 minutes in length or until all players on one team have been eliminated WHICHEVER COMES FIRST. If the game ends with the buzzer at 5 minutes, the team with the most players still on the court wins!
- ✓ TEAMS NEED A TEAM CAPTAIN. This person will serve as the contact person for the team
- ✓ Teams raising the most money have an opportunity to receive first- and possibly second-round byes
- ✓ Teams will be ranked according to how much money they have contributed to the tournament

THE FIRST PLACE TEAM WILL RECEIVE A PRIZE:

OFFICIAL GUIDELINES

1. When the referee blows his whistle... *ALL GAMES BEGIN!!!* Games go on until all members from one of the teams have been eliminated or until the five minute buzzer sounds. If the game ends due to the buzzer, then the team with the most players still standing is the winner of the match.

IF THERE IS A TIE: The game will go into a **2 minute sudden-death period.** If there is still no winner after this period, sudden-death rules will continue until a winner is determined.

- 2. Once a ball hits the wall, floor, or referee, it is a **DEAD BALL.** (It is no longer considered 'in play')
- 3. Ways to get out:

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- ➤ Being hit by a live ball from a member of the opposing team
- ➤ Throwing a ball at the opposing team and having a member from that team catch the ball you threw

- 4. If you catch a ball thrown from a member of the opposing team, you may bring back into the game **ONE** player from your team that has previously gotten out.
- 5. If a ball is deflected by another ball, it is still considered alive, and all above rules still apply.
- 6. Head shots will not be permitted!
- 7. ABSOLUTELY POSITIVELY **NO PROFANITY, DEROGATORY** OR **ABUSIVE** LANGUAGE OR ACTIONS WILL BE TOLERATED!
- 8. What the referee says *goes*. No objections or arguments will be tolerated.
