In August 2009, Jason and his business partner Mike Szymczak launched OrigAudio, which is now recognized worldwide. In their early careers, Jason and Mike traveled constantly and wanted an easy way to listen to music while on the road. It was during their travels that the idea for OrigAudio came about as they recognized the need for a portable solution for listening to music while on the go. Inspired by a Chinese take-out box - foldable, easily compactable, and recyclable - the 'origami of audio' was born. Three months after launching, OrigAudio was named to Time Magazine's "50 Best Inventions of 2009" list and appeared on ABC's hit start-up business show, "Shark Tank", which gained worldwide recognition for the company. OrigAudio products are currently available at over 5,000 retail locations nationwide, 38

countries and online at www.origaudio.com.

Jason received the honor of being named Entrepreneur Magazine's "Entrepreneur of the Year" the company was also named to the prestigious INC. Magazine "500 Fastest Growing Companies in America" list. Lucash currently lives in California where he heads OrigAudio's corporate office and still travels for fun as he continues to expand the business.






Xavier Institute for Higher Leadership [Themed Training Sessions]
