About FBLA!

The Future Business Leaders of America (FBLA) is a non-profit 501(c)3 educational association with a quarter-million students preparing for careers in business and business-related fields. Pennsylvania FBLA consists of 294 active high schools and more than 13,900 members—the third largest state chapter in the national association. We attract students by designing inspiring programs to foster the development of individual business leadership skills, team skills, and communication.

The Purpose of FBLA

PA FBLA provides innovative leadership development programs to bring business and education together in a positive working relationship. Participation in FBLA can have a direct impact on the direction and success of a young person's career. Thousands of students have learned through active membership in FBLA about the world of business and what is expected of them in the workplace.

Pennsylvania FBLA Accomplishments in 2015-2016

We would like to share with you some of the achievements PA FBLA had this past year:

- We are the third largest state chapter in the national organization with 294 active chapters and 13,979 members (our highest membership ever in our history) third only to Georgia and Missouri and more than 20 new chapters joined our organization.
- PA FBLA had the largest delegation ever attend the National Leadership Conference in Chicago with more than 450 travelers.
- PA FBLA had the 3rd highest number of award winners at the 2016 NLC—third only to California and Georgia.
- Our State Leadership Conference held this past April continues to be close to 4,500 attendees, which is one of the largest state conferences in the national association
- We raised nearly \$48,500 for the 2015-2016 State Project, the Ronald McDonald Houses of Pennsylvania
- We moved just about everything we used to do by mail or UPS/FedEx to digital submissions, and we will continue that movement toward digital submissions.
- Our middle-level program continues to grow, and we offered an expanded program of events to reach as many ML students as possible. We reached 636 middle-level members in 25 active chapters, our largest membership ever.
- Our Virtual Chapter Membership continues to grow with more students participating in the program than ever before—giving options to students who are not in a traditional brick-and-mortar schools or who are in schools where no FBLA chapter exists.
- One of our largest and most successful State Leadership Workshops in our history was held this past November. Our State Leadership Workshop moves to Harrisburg this year and will be located at the Harrisburg Hilton.

• In a major change in how we operate our competitive events at the State Leadership Conference, our pre-conference and on-site judges all used an online system to submit their rankings which had a tremendous impact on accuracy and how quickly we were able to calculate rankings. Those efforts are now considered a potential model for the national office to implement at the National Leadership Conference.

There's a lot of progress, service, education, leadership, and excitement going on in FBLA, and we are inviting you to become a part of our leadership program. Your participation in our workshops and conferences over the years is one of the reasons why we are so successful. Thank you for all you do for the members of **Pennsylvania FBLA**.

The SLW is designed to inspire, educate, and motivate students and advisers as they set new educational and FBLA goals for the year. This is accomplished through motivational general sessions, leadership workshops, professional development sessions for advisers, and visiting with exhibitors who provide a wide variety of products and/or services.

- SPECIAL SLW EXHIBITOR DISCOUNT PRICING is now available for vendors who attend both the State Leadership Workshop (November 6-7, 2016) and State Leadership Conference (April 3-5, 2017) within the same school year AND pre-pay fees for both events by October 28, 2016. If a power source is needed, there is an additional fee of \$45 per table per event.
