Meals are not included in the price you pay to attend SLW. Additionally, many restaurants in downtown Harrisburg close at 5 p.m. on Sunday. The Harrisburg Property Services, Inc. (HPS), has arranged for us to purchase food from a total of nine (9) different eateries in Strawberry Square on Sunday and Monday.

Strawberry Square is attached to the Hilton by way of the Arcade (an enclosed walkway). Not only is Strawberry Square conveniently located to the Hilton, but the eateries offer quality food at reasonable prices. These nine tenants have extended their hours of operation to complement our workshop schedule on Sunday and Monday. Strawberry Square is normally closed on Sunday; however, these nine vendors have agreed to open **specifically** for SLW attendees. All exit doors will be locked from the outside. You must enter through the Arcade. Vendors will accept cash, credit or debit cards.
