2016 State Leadership Workshop Update #4 – Vehicle Parking at the Hilton Harrisburg

The Hilton is located in center-city Harrisburg. Parking is at a premium. When we originally introduced the Hilton as a future site for the SLW, we indicated that parking fees would apply. At this point, we are happy to report that all Hilton overnight guests will have complimentary parking. However, not all vehicles will be able to park in the connected Walnut Street Garage due to size restrictions. Below are the details:

Complimentary parking for Hilton overnight guests will be available at the following locations:

1) <u>Walnut Street Garage</u> – attached to the Hilton (Note: vehicles with a height of 6'6" or more will NOT fit in the garage.) [Know the height of your vehicle(s)]

2) <u>City Island Parking Lot</u> (just across the river from the hotel) is for larger school vans and buses. The Hilton will shuttle advisers/bus drivers back and forth from the Hilton to their vehicle. (Before parking in a satellite lot, unload your vehicle at the hotel)

3) **Farm Show Lower Lot** (less than a mile from the Hilton). The Hilton will shuttle advisers/bus drivers back and forth from the Hilton. (Before parking in a satellite lot, unload your vehicle at the hotel)

We understand that parking is an inconvenience in Harrisburg and possibly you may need to pay for parking if you are not a registered guest at the Hilton; however, we are working on free parking for all. To help with pre-planning, we ask all advisers (including those commuting) to complete the (Vehicle) Parking in Harrisburg at SLW WuFoo Form. We request your input to better serve you.

When completing the WuFoo form, here is what we need to know:

- 1. Whether you are an overnight guest or commuter
- 2. Date of arrival (Saturday, Sunday, or Monday)
- 3. What type and number of vehicles will be utilizing to transport you and your students to the SLW
- 4. Will your driver drop you off and pick you up on Monday (no parking required)
- 5. For the Dodgeball Tournament on Sunday evening, will you utilize our shuttle transportation (given that your vehicle will be in a satellite parking lot) or will you use your own vehicle(s) to drive your students to Central Dauphin East HS—the site of the Dodgeball Tournament.
