Overview of Tour (each chapter must select one of the four tours below) On June 27—Tours 1-4 are included in Gold Package); Tours 1-4 are an option for Blue Plan.

Tour #1 – <u>Washington DC, Arlington, Tysons Corner</u> - you will board a charter bus for the 40-minutes ride (traffic pending) to Washington, DC. A step-on-guide will spend the day with you as you get on and off the bus at famous historic sites. The group has a reservation to participate in a Wreath Laying Ceremony at Arlington National Cemetery. Once back on the bus, we will go to Tysons Corner for a little shopping and dinner.

Tour #2 - <u>Annapolis City</u> - You will board a charter bus for the 40-minute ride to Annapolis. Once in Annapolis, there are two activities from which to choose. (these choices must be decided when booking your travel package with PA FBLA.) Both tours in Annapolis end on Kent Island for a fabulous all-you-can-eat crab feast.

- A. <u>Chesapeake Bay Schooner Sailing Adventure</u> Come sail away on a Woodwind Chesapeake Bay Schooner for a unique, interactive sailing experience. If the winds are right, the cruise may take you under the Chesapeake Bay Bridge for a breathtaking experience. From the yoeman to the "sea bee" sailor, this tour is a true delight.
- B. Annapolis City renowned both as the State Capital of Maryland and America's Sailing Capital, prides itself as a history-laden waterside town with great shopping and dining. Annapolis, one of the three major cities in the DC metro area, is minutes away from hundreds of miles of Chesapeake shoreline, countless recreational possibilities on the water, and maritime villages that harken back to simpler times.

Tour #3 - <u>Annapolis Naval Academy</u> - This guided walking tour takes you inside the Naval Academy and includes Lejeune Hall, Bancroft Hall, Tecumseh Court, Herndon Monument, Main Chapter and the Crypt of John Paul Jones. This guided tour gives you a behind-the-scenes glimpse of every facet of a midshipman. After the tour, you will board the charter bus, head over the Chesapeake Bay Bridge to Kent Island, for a fabulous all-you-can eat crab feast.

Tour #4 = <u>Experience Baltimore</u> - Board a charter bus, meet your step-on-guide and explore the historical sites of Charm City! This tour ends at Lexington Market for a late lunch. Lexington Market is like the Farmer's Market in LA and Reading Market in Philadelphia. With over 100 vendors, the Lexington Market is a foodie delight.

Hard Rock Café Baltimore – shuttle buses will be available to take you from the Sheraton to the Hard Rock Cafe.

Baltimore Orioles & Camden Yards – we will walk to Camden Yards for dinner; from our box seats under cover, we will watch the Orioles vs. Anaheim Angels baseball game.

<u>Spirit of Baltimore Dinner Cruise</u> - after a busy week, relax in the warm summer breeze as we cruise around the Inner Harbor. Dinner and entertainment will be provided.
