Pins are presented at the National Leadership Conference. If in attendance, will be recognized on stage at the State Leadership Conference.

- Focuses on local, regional, and state involvement; intermediate business skills; and leadership in the community.
- DEADLINE MARCH 1

LEADER AWARD

- LEVEL 3
- Focuses on local, regional, state, and national involvement; advanced business skills, and community leadership.
- DEADLINE MARCH 1

AMERICA AWARD

- LEVEL 4
- Focuses on total association leadership, business skills, and involvement in the community.
- DEADLINE APRIL 25
