

- All testing must be done at:
 - Home location
 - Under adult supervision
- Performance events done by:
 - Video submission
 - Reviewed by panel of state judges
- Team event testing done by:
 - Students at a common location
 - Attend under adult supervision



State Leadership Conference

- Must qualify in your event
- All attendees will follow the same guidelines
 - Comply with Delegate Code of Conduct
 - Compete on site with all students
 - Submit any competitive components by deadlines
- Be accompanied by an adult
- All fees are incurred by the student and must be paid by the designated deadline
- May have two voting delegates
