Singing the National Anthem during the Opening General Session in front of 3,600 members and advisers is an honor and a memorable experience. Please check with your members, your choral directors, etc., to investigate the vocal talent of the members from your chapter already registered to attend the SLC. Below are the procedures to audition to sing the National Anthem at the 2010 SLC:

1. Make a demo MP3 (preferred) or CD/DVD (no tapes) recording of your rendition of the National Anthem.

3. The deadline to submit a demo audition is **Monday, March 15, 2010**. Please include your name, school, email address and phone number. Team Cybis will review all demo recordings and notify applicants via email. Audition recordings will not be returned.
4. Team Cybis will notify the successful candidate no later than **Friday, April 2, 2010**.
