Pennsylvania has set a <u>new state record</u> with 50 individual, team, chapter, and state awards (and a new state record totaling eight 1st-place finishers) at the July 1 FBLA National Awards Program in Chicago. According to the event finalists published on the national FBLA site, Pennsylvania has the second highest number of award winners at the NLC (second only to California's 53 award winners) and the highest number of first-place award winners (excluding open competitive events winners).
