Procedure



Chapters are invited to prepare a basket prior to the State Leadership Workshop. To create a basket it is encouraged to choose a theme for the basket. Ideas can vary from sports themes, back-to-school themes, or even candy themes

(*Any food items MUST be in their original packaging and unopened*).



Upon arrival at the SLW, chapters should report to the Basket Auction Registration Table to register their respective basket.



Once your basket has been registered, chapters will receive documentation that will be used if the individual chapter chooses to use the basket raffle as points towards the Outstanding Chapter Criteria.



During the conference, FBLA members and advisors will have the opportunity to purchase tickets and place them in the basket of their choice. There will be a designated area for the basket auction where tickets may be purchased.

Prices will be as follows:

~3 Tickets= \$1.00

~7 Tickets= \$2.00

~20 Tickets= \$5.00



During the Closing Session of the State Leadership Workshop, the winning tickets for each basket will drawn randomly. Winners must be present at the Closing Session in order to win. Also, winners must have their ticket stub in order to claim a basket. If a basket is not claimed after the ticket is called a second ticket will be drawn. This process will continue until someone present at the Closing Session presents a winning ticket.



Rules



Chapters MAY donate more than one basket, however, only one basket may be used to claim points for Outstanding Chapter Criteria



The recommended price range on contained items must fall in the price range of (\$30-\$40)



All baskets MUST be wrapped in a see through material so no contents are removed or lost (EXAMPLES: Clear cellophane, Plastic Wrap, Netting, etc.)



Each Chapter must turn in copies of all receipts for donated basket items at the time the basket is registered.

Awards



Each chapter will be able to claim 5 service points on the outstanding chapter criteria #65 if the basket is worth \$30 or more.



Chapters will be assisting and raising money for the 2009-2010 state project for the Habitat for Humanity Society.



Providing support towards PA FBLA reaching the monetary goal of \$75,000, the cost to build a home.
