Qualifying members and advisers traveled from all across the state to attend Pennsylvania FBLA's 64<sup>th</sup> annual State Leadership Conference held at the Hershey Lodge in Hershey, Pennsylvania. The four-day conference, held from April 12<sup>th</sup> to April 15<sup>th</sup>, was full of networking, friendship building, competition, leadership training, and excitement.

Upon arrival on Sunday, many members and advisers took advantage of several nearby tourist attractions, including Hershey Park and Hershey's Chocolate World. Even though the park's closing at 6 o'clock sent members back to their hotels, the fun didn't stop there! On Sunday night, Pennsylvania FBLA hosted a game night in the Hershey Lodge's Chocolate Ballroom.

On Monday morning, those in attendance at this year's SLC awoke bright and early and began competing in over fifty events. Throughout the day, workshops on a variety of topics were also available for members to attend. Later that evening, the Opening Session, an exciting "kick-off" to the conference, was held in the Great American Hall, with near 4,500 people in attendance. Members and advisers had the privilege of hearing from keynote speaker Mike Smith, who encouraged Pennsylvania FBLA to strive to become more than just an ordinary face in the crowd.

Also during this session, the candidates for state office ascended the stage to deliver their campaign speeches. To conclude the day's activities, campaign booths were opened and each chapter's voting delegates were able to speak with the candidates one-on-one.

Tuesday was another eventful day! That morning, members excelled in the final rounds of their competitive events, and later in the day, they attended the Business Session. At this session, region officers were introduced and several state awards were distributed. Before the adjournment of this meeting, the 2015-2016 state officer team results were also announced. At the Awards of Excellence later that

night, the top ten from each event were brought to the stage to be recognized for their efforts in the competitive events.

Pennsylvania FBLA’s members and advisers made the entire state “Pennsylvania Proud” at this year’s State Leadership Conference.
